**School Profile** 2023/2024



Santa Cruz High School is a comprehensive public school with a student population of approximately 1,150 in grades nine through twelve. SCHS is particularly noted for having a diverse student body. Students from various racial, cultural and socio-economic backgrounds and lifestyles join to enrich their personal and academic experiences in an unusually compatible atmosphere. In addition to comprehensive college preparation and vocational curriculums, many special programs are available on our campus. Santa Cruz High, a California Distinguished School, accredited by the Western Association of Schools and Colleges, is situated in the heart of the city of Santa Cruz, a coastal community of 64,000 people.

#### HONORS and AP CLASSES CURRICULUM Science: **English:** Santa Cruz High School utilizes the Excel Block Schedule. Under this model, students take three or four 90-minute classes Physiology (H) English 2 (H) each day for 18 weeks in the fall, and three or four different Enviro Sci. (AP) English Lang & Comp (AP) classes for 18 weeks in the spring. The daily 90-minute classes Chemistry (AP) English Lit & Comp (AP) are equivalent to year-long classes in more traditional two-AP Physics 1 (AP) semester systems. ### **GRADING** and **RANKING**

#### **GPA Calculations:**


**Cumulative unweighted GPA:** Unweighted calculation of all courses taken in grades 9-12.

- **Cumulative weighted GPA**: Unweighted calculation of college prep classes taken in grades 10 12.
- Academic 10-12 GPA: Weighted calculation of academic courses completed in grades 10 12, in which one extra point is given for each honors and advanced placement course with a grade C or better.
- **Class rank:** Based on the student's Weighted Academic 10-12 GPA.
